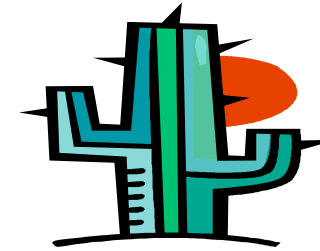
THE SALVATION ARMY'S DAY IN THE PARK

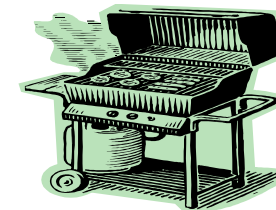
